### **Donovan School District Board Member Vacancy**

The Donovan School District is accepting applications to fill the vacancy resulting from the resignation of Eric Schmidt. The individual selected will serve on the School Board from the date of appointment to May 1, 2021.

Applicants for the Board vacancy must at a minimum, meet the following qualifications:

- Be a United States citizen
- Be at least 18 years of age
- Be a resident of Illinois and the District for at least one year immediately preceding the appointment
- Be a registered voter
- Not be a child sex offender
- Not hold another incompatible public office
- Not have a prohibited interest in any contract with the District
- Not be a school trustee
- Not hold certain types of prohibited state or federal employment
- Meet residency requirements based on Congressional Townships

Applicants should show familiarity with the Board's policies regarding general duties and responsibilities of a Board and a Board member, including fiduciary responsibilities, conflict of interest, ethics, and gift ban.
